



POSTER SESSION: Preparation and Presentation Guidelines

Posters will be presented during the poster session. All posters will be displayed at the same time and in the same room. The authors should be available during this time and they will explain and answer questions about their work to the rest of the ECSA participants.

POSTER PREPARATION GUIDELINES

- 1. Size:** The size of the poster must be an A0.
- 2. Heading:** A heading label including the title, author name(s), and the affiliation(s) should be included. The recommended lettering size is 3 cm (1-3/16"). This should be at the top of the poster.
- 3. Structure:** Posters should be easily understood. The content of each poster should be clearly divided into sections including introduction, problem definition (or aim of work), work summary, results, and conclusions.
- 4. Legibility:** The poster should be readable from a distance of at least 3 m. Suggested sizes are a minimum graph size of 25 cm (10"), section heading letters of 2 cm (3/4"), and text and figure lettering not less than 1 cm (3/8").
- 5. Aesthetic:** It is recommend not only to use text, but also to use diagrams, tables, graphs, data, pictures, etc., that represent the main ideas of the work. It will be well evaluated. Table, diagrams and graphs that are results of the work should be titled. It is not necessary to title those pictures that are used to represent an idea.
- 6. Presentation:** A good presentation and explanation of the work during the poster session will be also well evaluated. The author can prepare extra material of the work for the participants, such as preprints of the poster in A4.

BEST POSTER AWARD

There will be a **"Best Poster Award"** for the best poster decided by three judges. The decision will be based on the criteria above presented and the aesthetic look of the poster.
